GLOSSARY OF TERMS

TRANSITS: Transits to Natal Interpretations

The subject of Fate or Destiny has triggered many a philosophical argument. What is destiny? Are the details of our lives pre-destined? How much free will do we really have? These are imponderable questions. This report does not offer the answers. Rather it gives us some signposts to help us on our life journey.

When meteorologists forecast the weather we understand that they are not telling us how to live our lives. Rather they are giving us information that may help us make our own decisions. As far as the weather is concerned our major decisions are whether or not to dress warmly or to take an umbrella. The astrological system of Transits is offering us much the same information. It is giving us an indication of the emotional and intellectual weather of our lives. It is up to us to decide our own destiny.

These interpretations have been written to apply to transits to a geocentric tropical natal chart using a quadrant-based house system. When using these interpretations, please bear in mind that, inevitably, every chart will contain some contradictory influences, and as a result certain interpretations of different items in the same chart may seem difficult to reconcile. However, this may still be an accurate reflection of what is happening to the individual whose transits are being interpreted, as people do experience conflicting desires, events and circumstances in their lives. It is the responsibility of the astrologer to synthesise these apparent contradictions in order to present a cohesive and realistic interpretation of the dilemmas of the chart.

PROGRESSIONS: Progression Interpretations

Astrologers use the term "Progressions" to describe a particular technique of moving planets forward in time. This technique is aptly named because it describes how a person progresses through their life. Progressions describe the different phases in our lives as well as our inner urges and how they affect our lives rather than dramatic outer events. However, our urges can significantly affect the way in which we react to circumstances and therefore our decisions. It is important that we go with the flow rather than fight against the tides of our lives. Therefore Progressions are likely to show us signposts in life's journey and consequently help us gain wisdom and understanding. Some astrologers believe that Progressions are signs from our soul or higher self; others place less emphasis. We suggest that you read on and see for yourself.

ASPECTS in ASTROLOGY

In astrology, an aspect is defined by the angular distance between two planets. The nature of the aspect depends on the number of degrees separating the two planets. Aspects are of utmost importance in assessing the natal chart because they help in identifying the nature of the relationship, whether hard or soft, between the energies released by the planets involved, which constitutes all the complexity and richness of the personality.

Aspects express themselves more or less strongly according to their importance, or lack of. Moreover, angles between planets never exactly match the standard definition of aspects. Thus, the exactness of the aspect, referred to as "orb" in astrology, is to be considered. If the orb is tight (almost exact aspect), the aspect is more powerful. If the planets are linked by a wide orb aspect, their influence is less strong. Each aspect is allowed a different orb, and traditionally, some astrology schools assign them slightly differing coefficients.

In natal charts, usually accepted orbs (exactness of aspect) are 9 to 10 degrees for oppositions and conjunctions, 7 to 8 degrees for trines and squares, 4 to 5 degrees for sextiles, 2 degrees for quincunxes and sesqui-squares, around 1 degree for semi-sextiles and semi-squares, and often 0.5 to 1 degree for quintiles and their family (semi-quintiles and bi-quintiles).

Much smaller orbs are used in forecasting and synastry works because these techniques require that aspects be more exact if they are to be efficient.

Orb

An aspect between planets or sensitive points is usually allowed some inexactitude, which is called its orb of influence. This comes from the idea of a halo or aura surrounding a planet, comprising its rays. Traditional astrology allows different orbs for each of the planets, but modern astrology works primarily on an orb of aspect. Major aspects are allowed a greater orb than minor ones. For example, a conjunction is usually allowed an orb of 8 degrees, whereas a semi-sextile would only be allowed an orb of 2 degrees of arc. The Moon is usually allowed more orb than other planets, while faster planets are allowed more orb than slower ones. Greater orb is allowed in natal astrology than in mundane, where timing is more critical.

Aspect Definitions

Conjunction

As indicated by its name, it is formed when two planets are on the same degree, or when they are very close to each other, usually within an 8° orb of arc. The conjunction takes a positive or negative influence, depending on the other aspects formed. It can also be neutral. It may also depend on the nature of the two planets involved. Its function is to combine and blend the characteristics of the planets' energies. A conjunction is usually a helpful energy which creates self-nurturing, inner strength and ambition. Depending on the planets involved, it can also create intensity, stress and confusion.

Quincunx

An angle of 150°, this is a very interesting aspect which takes its nature from both the trine and the square. It unites two energies of different elements and modalities, blends their characteristics, and offers their assets to the native, but on condition that on the one hand, he accepts to put up the required efforts, and on the other hand, that the planets involved are not of opposite nature, and preferably, that they are complementary (Mars and Venus, Mercury and Uranus, the Sun and the Moon, etc.). The quincunx often coincides with situations in which matters seem to be somehow out of joint or where adjustment of some kind is required. Classed as inconjunct and considered particularly unfortunate by the ancients, this aspect is not thought unduly malefic by many modern astrologers, but rather calls for tweaking and adaptation in order to make things run more smoothly.

Opposition

A generally adverse aspect of 180 degrees, this aspect connects two planets which are at opposite poles of the chart, and are thus, in two complementary zodiac signs. Such planets are said to be in opposition. They are in contradiction with each other and try to gain the upper hand on the other one, which results in the native's being psychologically torn between the two poles of the opposition. Traditionally, it is considered a negative aspect since it brings about tensions, but it allows to evolve if one strives to master its contrasts. At maturity, it is possible to turn the tension into an asset and strength by harmoniously blending the characteristics of the two planets so connected.

Semi-sextile

A minor benefic aspect of 30 degrees. Some traditional astrologers do not count this as an aspect, due to the phenomenon known as Aversion. Considered rather harmonious. Actually, it proves quite delicate because two adjacent signs are always very different from each other, and you can have fun checking them out. In transits, this can indicate a mildly irritating time.

Semi-square (semi-quadrate)

A minor adverse aspect of 45 degrees, deriving from Kepler. Also known as octile. It is an aspect of tension like the square, though much weaker. As such, it makes the native move ahead and evolve, but in a less intense way than the square.

Sextile

A benefic aspect of 60 degrees. Stimulating and dynamic, stirring people into action positively. Like the trine, it is beneficial and is a factor of harmony between the planets involved. However, its effects are more concrete than with the trine and are expressed more outwardly. In practice, this aspect is considered the aspect of communication par excellence. The planets involved perfectly and actively exchange their energies.

Square

Major challenging aspect which is formed when two planets are 90 degrees apart. Like the opposition, it is an aspect of tension, with the planets in constant conflict, and the native strongly feeling their struggle. In order to overcome them, he must continuously fight against the difficulties set by their energies. The aspect endows with strength and the ability to overcome a great many hurdles in life, provided that the person has much courage and tenacity. Leaders and people with exceptional destinies often have many squares in their natal chart. Squares prevent them from keeping still and prompt them to continuously move ahead, create, and evolve, since immobility is difficult to bear when such constant tensions crop up. The square is the most interesting aspect, even though it is obviously desirable to also have a few soft aspects such as sextiles and trines.

Trine

Major favourable aspect of 120 degrees which is formed when two planets are positioned in signs belonging to the same element, and are thus compatible. Such planets support each other and create a feeling of well-being and easiness since they are in harmony with each other. It is an aspect of good luck and psychological comfort. However, it can lead to self-indulgence and passivity. Indeed, too much easiness is no incentive to effort...As indicated by its name, it is formed when two planets are on the same degree, or when they are very close to each other. Conflicting emotions abound during this period. Some events may seem to be very upsetting and yet contrarily also very healing. Dreams, meditation and creative visualisation can be very powerful right now. It is important that you take time to enjoy the simple pleasures in life and to listen to your intuition. If you can take time to reflect and nurture yourself then you are likely to reap large rewards. These rewards are unlikely to be monetary. They are more likely to be of an emotional or spiritual nature. For instance you may feel a soothing awareness that you have been able to let go of past hurts and have rejuvenated your sense of purpose. On the other hand you may develop a deep appreciation of your existing lifestyle and relationships.

PROGRESSED MOON SQUARE PROGRESSED JUPITER (9th House to 12th House)

Entering 2 Jun 2010, Exact 3 Jul 2010, Leaving 2 Aug 2010

Everything seems a little larger than life right now. You feel as if all of your dreams and wishes are coming true now. In some ways you are correct. Life is full of many rewards right now. However, you need to make choices rather than try to take on every opportunity that comes your way. If you are not careful you may well overindulge and overestimate your own abilities. As a result your life may become imbalanced. You need to make sure that you do not neglect one area of your life as you pursue your own goals. You need to balance your home, family, work and marriage, with your own interests and appetites. The problem is that you are currently going through a somewhat egotistical stage. PROGRESSED MOON ENTERING CANCER (9th House)

12 Jun 2010

TRANSITING JUPITER SEMISQUARE NATAL SATURN (5th House to 6th House)

In Orb 11 Feb 2010, Exact 13 Feb 2010, Leaving 17 Feb 2010

During this transit you may have difficulty striking a balance between your own personal goals and your responsibilities. Tension may arise as you feel the need to break out of old restrictions, but are frustrated in your attempts. Although your tolerance level may be low, you would do well to cultivate the assistance of others, rather than meeting them head on or simply giving up on them.
